### **Invitation to Comment on the Draft Distributed Generation Renewable Energy Credits Contract Forms Procurement of Distributed Generation Renewable Energy Credits for the Ameren Portfolio, the ComEd Portfolio and the MidAm Portfolio**

#### **Invitation to Comment**

On September 28, 2015, the Illinois Power Agency (“IPA”) submitted its Procurement Plan (“Plan”) to the Illinois Commerce Commission (“ICC”) in compliance with Public Act 095-0481 (the “Act”), which includes the Illinois Power Agency Act (“IPA Act”). The ICC approved the Plan with modifications on December 16, 2015. The Plan provides for the procurement of Renewable Energy Credits (“RECs”) from distributed renewable energy generation devices (“DG”) through a Request for Proposals (“RFP”). The RFP will procure DG RECs using funds already collected from alternative compliance payments for the portfolio of Ameren Illinois Company (“Ameren Illinois” or “AIC”) and the portfolio of Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”), and using the renewable resources budget for the portfolio of MidAmerican Energy Company (“MidAmerican” or “MidAm”).

The applicable supplier contract for the procurement of DG RECs for each of AIC, ComEd and MidAm are posted to the [Renewable Energy Resources Section](#) of the procurement website.

**The Procurement Administrator invites interested parties to submit their comments on all draft contract forms.**

#### **Timeline and Process**

The timeline and process for interested parties to provide comments on all proposed changes are as follows:

- You may submit your comments on the Draft (AIC) DG Renewable Energy Credit Agreement, the Draft (ComEd) Master DG REC Purchase and Sale Agreement, and/or (MidAm) DG Renewable Energy Credit Agreement as tracked changes in Microsoft Word. A word version of all three contract forms can be found on the Renewable Energy Resources Section of the procurement website under the “Spring 2016 Distributed Generation Renewable Energy Credit Agreements” heading.
- We strongly encourage you to provide explanatory notes either in a separate document or highlighted in tracked changes.
- You must provide a telephone number and email contact information in the event that the Procurement Administrator seeks clarification regarding your comments.
